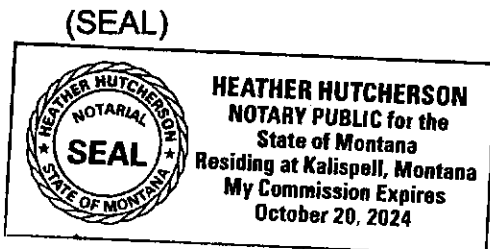

To the best of my knowledge and according to the rules governing trustee elections, a trustee must register with the COPP if their district contains more than 15,000 registered voters. This trustee is currently holding a position on the Flathead County, Kalispell School District 5 board of trustees. It does not appear that this person has EVER registered with the COPP. Given this trustee holds an elected position attained against the rules, is their position invalid? Will they have to run for re-election this cycle? What are the repercussions for violating the COPP rules? This information and these questions are time sensitive as we are just 33 days away from the election. Thank you in advance for your time.
