

Introduction:

Gene Jarussi, Karen Jarussi, Neighbors for Responsible Legislators, and 2016 Legislative Candidate Jessica Karjala engaged in multiple violations of Montana's campaign finance laws. Their efforts display a clear pattern of disregard for the laws of the state of Montana by engaging in illegal coordination between a political committee and candidate for public office and failing to properly report electioneering activity.

This pattern of behavior is especially troubling considering that Mr. Jarussi has in the past, and is currently, serving as a Special Attorney General on behalf of the Commissioner of Political Practices office and that the illegal activities in question occurred while Mr. Jarussi was acting in that capacity and prosecuting others for similar alleged violations.

The fact that Mr. Jarussi was representing the CoPP in cases that involve allegations of coordination between a candidate and committee, as well as campaign reporting violations, all the while committing these same violations himself is unconscionable. The ethical issues raised in this complaint call into question whether Mr. Jarussi's actions constitute an abuse of his position of public trust and disqualify him from serving in his capacity as Special Attorney General. Until a determination is made on these issues, he should be removed from any and all active cases immediately.

Given the fact that Mr. Jarussi is actively representing the CoPP in District Court, it is only appropriate that the Commissioner and the Commissioner's legal counsel recuse themselves from considering this complaint to avoid any appearance of impropriety.

Since it has become the practice of the Commissioner's office to appoint Democrat lawyers to pursue cases against Republican officeholders and organizations, I would hope that the Commissioner would continue to apply the same practice and appoint a Republican lawyer to pursue this case.

The illegal actions undertaken by Gene Jarussi, Karen Jarussi, Jessica Karjala and Neighbors for Responsible Legislators serve as a stunning reminder of the lengths politicians and their supporters will go to cheat to win office.

The specific violations of Gene Jarussi, Karen Jarussi, Neighbors for Responsible Legislators, and 2016 Legislative Candidate Jessica Karjala are outlined in detail on the attached pages.

Montana ARM 44.11.502 states:

EXPENDITURES, REPORTING

(1) A campaign expense paid personally by an individual in his or her own campaign is always coordinated with, and is a campaign expense of, the campaign that must be reported and disclosed as an expense by the campaign in the same manner as an expense paid through the campaign depository account.

(2) An obligation to pay for a campaign expenditure is incurred on the date the obligation is made, and shall be reported as a debt of the campaign until the campaign pays the obligation by making an expenditure.

(3) An expenditure is made on the date payment is made, or in the case of an in-kind expenditure, on the date the consideration is given.

(4) The date of each expenditure shall be reported in the reporting period during which it is made.

(5) Expenditures made from the petty cash fund need not be reported, except that an accounting shall be maintained pursuant to ARM 44.11.409.

(6) All expenditures must be supported by a contemporaneous written agreement, invoice, billing statement, or similar documentation appropriate to the transaction that describes the services provided, the billing period identifying the specific dates on which services were provided, an itemized basis for the payments made, and other pertinent information.

(7) For purposes of the disclosure requirements of 13-37-229 and 13-37-232, MCA, the "purpose" of each expenditure as reported on the commissioner's campaign finance reporting forms shall specifically describe the purpose, quantity, subject matter, as appropriate to each expenditure, and must be detailed enough to distinguish among expenditures for similar purposes. For example, two expenditures for direct mail advertisements should not both be reported as "Flyers."

(8) Reporting independent expenditures:

(a) shall be reported in accordance with the procedures for reporting other expenditures;

(b) a person making an independent expenditure shall report the name of the candidate or committee the independent expenditure was intended to benefit, and the fact that the expenditure was independent; and

(c) the candidate or political committee benefiting from the independent expenditure does not have to report the expenditure.

(9) For the purposes of 13-37-226, MCA:

(a) the reports required to be filed within two business days shall be filed electronically, pursuant to ARM 44.11.302; and

(b) all expenditures and contributions reported under (a) shall also be included on the post-election report.

1. Violation ARM 44.11.501(7)

The Neighbors for Responsible Legislators(NFRL) 9/16/2017-10/04/2016 c6 report (Exhibit 1) lists an expenditure of \$771.50 to Allegra of Billings, MT described only as "Print door hangers and drill holes for hanging." The committee's failure to include the purpose, quantity, and subject matter is a violation of the standard set forth in ARM.

2. Violation ARM 44.11.501(8)(b)

The NFRL 9/16/2017-10/04/2016 c6 report (Exhibit 1) lists an expenditure of \$771.50 to Allegra of Billings, MT described only as "Print door hangers and drill holes for hanging." The committee's failure to include the name of the candidate or committee the independent expenditure was intended to benefit, and the fact that the expenditure was independent is a violation of the standard set forth in ARM.

3. Violation ARM 44.11.501(8)(b)

The NFRL 10/05/2017-10/27/2016 c6 report (Exhibit 2) lists an in-kind contribution of \$65.00 from Karen Jarussi of Billings, MT described only as "Promotion of Facebook posts." The committee's failure to include the name of the candidate or committee the independent expenditure was intended to benefit, and the fact that the expenditure was independent is a violation of the standard set forth in ARM.

Montana Code Annotated 13-37-229 states:

Disclosure requirements for candidates, ballot issue committees, political party committees, and independent committees.

(1) The reports required under 13-37-225 through 13-37-227 from candidates, ballot issue committees, political party committees, and independent committees must disclose the following information concerning contributions received:

(a) the amount of cash on hand at the beginning of the reporting period;

(b) the full name, mailing address, occupation, and employer, if any, of each person who has made aggregate contributions, other than loans, of \$35 or more to a candidate or political committee, including the purchase of tickets and other items for events, such as dinners, luncheons, rallies, and similar fundraising events;

(c) for each person identified under subsection (1)(b), the aggregate amount of contributions made by that person within the reporting period and the total amount of contributions made by that person for all reporting periods;

(d) the total sum of individual contributions made to or for a political committee or candidate and not reported under subsections (1)(b) and (1)(c);

(e) the name and address of each political committee or candidate from which the reporting committee or candidate received any transfer of funds, together with the amount and dates of all transfers;

(f) each loan from any person during the reporting period, together with the full names, mailing addresses, occupations, and employers, if any, of the lender and endorsers, if any, and the date and amount of each loan;

(g) the amount and nature of debts and obligations owed to a political committee or candidate, in the form prescribed by the commissioner;

(h) an itemized account of proceeds that total less than \$35 from a person from mass collections made at fundraising events;

(i) each contribution, rebate, refund, or other receipt not otherwise listed under subsections (1)(b) through (1)(h) during the reporting period;

(j) the total sum of all receipts received by or for the committee or candidate during the reporting period; and

(k) other information that may be required by the commissioner to fully disclose the sources of funds

used to support or oppose candidates or issues.

(2) (a) Except as provided in subsection (2)(c), the reports required under 13-37-225 through 13-37-227 from candidates, ballot issue committees, political party committees, and independent committees must disclose the following information concerning expenditures made:

(i) the full name, mailing address, occupation, and principal place of business, if any, of each person to whom expenditures have been made by the committee or candidate during the reporting period, including the amount, date, and purpose of each expenditure and the total amount of expenditures made to each person;

(ii) the full name, mailing address, occupation, and principal place of business, if any, of each person to whom an expenditure for personal services, salaries, and reimbursed expenses has been made, including the amount, date, and purpose of that expenditure and the total amount of expenditures made to each person;

(iii) the total sum of expenditures made by a political committee or candidate during the reporting period;

(iv) the name and address of each political committee or candidate to which the reporting committee or candidate made any transfer of funds, together with the amount and dates of all transfers;

(v) the name of any person to whom a loan was made during the reporting period, including the full name, mailing address, occupation, and principal place of business, if any, of that person and the full names, mailing addresses, occupations, and principal places of business, if any, of the endorsers, if any, and the date and amount of each loan;

(vi) the amount and nature of debts and obligations owed by a political committee or candidate in the form prescribed by the commissioner; and

(vii) other information that may be required by the commissioner to fully disclose the disposition of funds used to support or oppose candidates or issues.

(b) Reports of expenditures made to a consultant, advertising agency, polling firm, or other person that performs services for or on behalf of a candidate or political committee must be itemized and described in sufficient detail to disclose the specific services performed by the entity to which payment or reimbursement was made.

(c) A candidate is required to report the information specified in this subsection (2) only if the transactions involved were undertaken for the purpose of supporting or opposing a candidate.

4. Violation MCA13-37-229(1)(B)

The NFRL 9/16/2017-10/04/2016 c6 report (Exhibit 1) lists a contribution of \$500.00 from Gene Jarussi of Billings, MT and Occupation/Employer of "Retired/NA". However, a listing from Mr. Jarussi's law firm website (Exhibit 3) specifically states that Mr. Jarussi came out of retirement and serves in an "Of Counsel" role for the firm Bishop, Heenan and Davies. During this timeframe Mr. Jarussi was also serving in the capacity of Special Attorney General on behalf of the state of Montana. In all of Mr. Jarussi court filings on behalf of the state he continues to use the firm's physical address, as well as his firm email address. The committee's failure to accurately report the occupation and employment of Mr. Jarussi is a violation of the standard set forth in MCA.

5. Violation MCA13-37-229(1)(B)(E)

The NFRL 9/16/2017-10/04/2016 c6 report (Exhibit 1) lists an in-kind contribution of \$50.00 from the incidental committee Strange Sister Creative of Billings, MT described as "Donated design services for Door hanger". A search of the Commissioner of Political Practices records both the Hard Copy records and the CERS reveals no incidental committee filings for an incidental committee named "Strange Sister Creative" for the 2016 Election cycle. The CERS system did return 1 registration filing for "Strange Sister Creative" (Exhibit 4) for the 2000 election cycle. The filing is incomplete, listing no treasurer, officers, or committee account information and no financial reports are filed under that committee registration. The committee's failure to accurately report the committee and/or individual that made this contribution is a violation of the standard set forth in MCA.

Montana Code Annotated 13-37-210 states:

13-37-210. Naming and labeling of political committees. (1) Any political committee filing a certification and organizational statement pursuant to 13-37-201 shall:

- (a) name and identify itself in its organizational statement using a name or phrase:
 - (i) that clearly identifies the economic or other special interest, if identifiable, of a majority of its contributors; and
 - (ii) if a majority of its contributors share a common employer, that identifies the employer; and
 - (b) label any media advertisement or other paid public statement it makes or causes to be made in support of or opposition to any candidate or ballot issue by printing or broadcasting its name, as provided under subsection (1)(a), and position in support of or opposition to the candidate or ballot issue as a part of the media advertisement or other paid public statement.
- (2) The naming and labeling requirements in subsection (1) are reporting requirements for purposes of enforcement under 13-37-128.

6. Violation MCA13-37-210(a)(i)

The NFRL c6 reports show that it received contributions from 2 incidental committees: as discussed in violation #5 one of the committees in question has not reported with the CoPP so it is assumed to be fictitious and/or improperly cited and the other committee is an association of attorneys.

The Committee's c6 reports also show that it received contributions from 3 individuals: 2 listed occupation/employer of "retired/Na" and one as self-employed.

As previously discussed (violation #4) one of the individual donors, Mr. Jarussi is an attorney who came out of retirement, even though the committee erroneously listed "retired/NA". As his spouse, Karen Jarussi shares Mr. Jarussi's economic interest.

The committee has violated this statute by failing to properly identify the shared economic interest of 3 of its 5 contributors.

It is worth noting that these same deceptive naming practices were used by Mr. Jarussi's law partner and fellow Special Attorney General, John Heenan (*Eaton v Montanans for Experienced Judges COPP-2016-CFP-035*). In that case, Mr. Jarussi was also a contributor to the committee in question but it is not known what if any role he played in the committee's illegal activities.

Montana ARM 44.11.602 states:

COORDINATION

(1) A "coordinated expenditure" means any election communication, electioneering communication, or reportable election activity that is made by a person in cooperation with, in consultation with, under the control of, or at the direction of, in concert with, at the request or suggestion of, or with the express prior consent of a candidate or an agent of the candidate. The coordination of an expenditure need not require agreement, cooperation, consultation, request, or consent on every term necessary for the particular coordinated expenditure, but only requires proof of one element, such as content, price, or timing, to be met as a fact of a coordinated expenditure.

(2) When determining whether a communication or reportable election activity is coordinated the following may be considered, whether:

(a) it is based on information that is provided by the candidate or agent of the candidate directly or indirectly to the person funding or facilitating the communication or activity, or any person involved in creating, producing, or disseminating it.

(b) it was made by or through any candidate's agent in the course of the agent's involvement in the current campaign.

(c) the person funding or facilitating the communication or reportable election activity retains the paid services of a person or individual who:

(i) currently, or during the six months immediately preceding the election in which the candidate's name will appear on the ballot, received compensation from the candidate or the candidate's agent; and

(ii) the person or individual is involved in creating, producing, or disseminating the communication or reportable election activity.

(d) the communication or reportable election activity replicates, reproduces, republishes or disseminates, in whole or in substantial part, any material designed, produced and paid for, or distributed by the candidate, except as set forth in (3)(e).

(e) the candidate or the candidate's agent has made or participated in any discussion or in making any decision regarding the content, timing, location, media, intended audience, volume of distribution, or frequency of placement of the communication or activity.

(f) the person funding or facilitating the communication or reportable election activity has:

(i) established a written firewall policy designed to prevent the flow of information about the candidate's campaign plans, projects, activities, or needs from the persons providing services to the candidate to persons involved in the creation, production, or dissemination of the communication or activity; and

(ii) prior to the preparation or distribution of any communication or reportable election activity has distributed the firewall policy to all relevant employees, consultants, and clients affected by the policy; and

(iii) filed the firewall policy with the COPP.

(3) A "coordinated expenditure" does not mean any election communication, electioneering communication, or reportable election activity consisting of:

(a) an uncoordinated expenditure or an independent reportable election activity funded or facilitated by a person;

(b) services, food, or lodging provided in a manner that they are not contributions by a person within the meaning of contribution as defined by 13-1-101, MCA, or these rules;

(c) the cost funded or facilitated by a person for any bona fide news story, commentary, blog, or editorial distributed through the facilities of any broadcasting station, newspaper, magazine, or other periodical of general circulation;

(d) activity by an individual acting solely on his or her own behalf independently of any candidate or the candidate's agent; or

(e) the independent use of statements, images, or other information that is appropriated from a public source.

(4) A "coordinated expenditure" does not exist solely because:

(a) of personal or professional relationships between a candidate and other persons;

(b) the person funding or facilitating the communication or reportable election activity has previously made a contribution to the candidate;

(c) after publication or distribution, the person funding or facilitating the communication or reportable election activity informs the candidate or an agent of the candidate that the person has made an expenditure or funded the activity, provided that there is no other exchange of information, not otherwise available to the public, relating to details of the expenditure or funding the activity; or

(d) the funding or facilitating of the communication or reportable election activity is made at the request or suggestion of a candidate or an agent of a candidate for the benefit of another candidate or political committee where the other potentially benefitted candidate or political committee has no involvement.

(5) A "coordinated expenditure" shall be treated and reported as an in-kind contribution from and expenditure by the person funding, facilitating, or engaging in the election communication, electioneering communication, or reportable election activity. Both the candidate and the committee shall report the coordinated expenditure and/or in-kind contribution as the case may be.

7. Violation ARM 44.11.602

As the Treasurer and sole officer of Neighbors for Responsible Legislators committee, Karen Jarussi has violated the ARM 44.11.602 ban on coordination by simultaneously acting as a paid agent of Candidate Jessica Karjala's campaign committee and facilitating electioneering communication that benefited Ms. Karjala's campaign.

On 9/16/2016 Mrs. Jarussi filed the C2 statement of organization for Neighbors for Responsible Legislators (Exhibit 5). The form lists only Mrs. Jarussi as treasurer and no additional officers. The committee's only listed purpose is to participate in the HD48 legislative race, supporting Jessica Karjala and opposing Robert Saunders.

On 9/19/2016 the Jessica Karjala campaign committee (Exhibit 6) incurred a debt of \$120.00 to Karen Jarussi described as "Fundraiser". (It should be noted that this description doesn't meet the standards set for in ARM 44.11.502 and the campaign's deceptive reporting practices make it even harder for the public to discern the true circumstances of this expenditure). The campaign reported paying this debt on 9/21/16.

On or before 9/26/2016 the Neighbors for Responsible Legislators committee began production of a door hanger (Exhibit 7) opposing Ms. Karjala's opponent Robert Saunders. The committee's reports (Exhibit 1) show that it received an in-kind contribution of \$50.00 from Strange Sister Creative and made an expenditure to Strange Sister Creative of \$200.00 both described as "design services for door hanger". (It should be noted that this description doesn't meet the standards set forth in ARM 44.11.502. The lack of an adequate description and campaign's failure to properly identify the candidate benefitting from it make it even harder for the public to discern the true circumstances of this expenditure).

On 10/03/16, the committee paid Allegra of Billings, MT \$771.50 for printing of an unknown quantity of door hangers (Exhibit 1) and began distributing them to the public on or before 10/14/2016.

Between 10/04/16 and 10/27/16 the committee received a \$65.00 in-kind contribution from Mrs. Jarussi listed as "promotion of Facebook posts" (Exhibit 2). (Again, It should be noted that this description doesn't meet the standards set forth in ARM 44.11.502. The lack of an adequate description and the campaign's failure to

properly identify the candidate benefitting from it make it even harder for the public to discern the true circumstances of this expenditure).

By simultaneously providing paid services to the Karjala campaign and acting as the sole officer directing the election communications on her behalf for the Neighbors for Responsible Legislators committee, Mrs. Jarussi has violated at least 5 of the criteria in ARM 44.11.602 used to determine if an election communication is independent or coordinated.

While the level of Gene Jarussi's and Ms. Karjala's involvement in these particular violations is unclear from the publicly-filed reports, media interviews conducted by Mr. Jarussi (Exhibit 8) make it abundantly clear that he was involved both in Ms. Karjala's campaign and the activities of the NFRL committee. An investigation and thorough discovery process is warranted to reveal the true level of coordination between the Jarussi's, Neighbors for Responsible Legislators and Ms. Karjala.

8. Violation ARM 44.11.602

On an unknown date, prior to 10/22/16 candidate Jessica Karjala engaged Billings attorney Gene Jarussi to conduct opposition research on her 2016 opponent Robert Saunders (Exhibit 8) and turned over emails from a Saunders classmate that contained allegations potentially damaging to Saunders for Mr. Jarussi to investigate.

From the Billings Gazette 10/22/16:

Lundy got word to Saunders' opponent, Democratic Rep. Jessica Karjala, that comments allegedly made by Saunders at Patrick Henry deserved looking into. Karjala turned the emails over to attorney Gene Jarussi, who contacted Lundy, who recalled Saunders' making the comments about President Obama.

Upon contacting the witness in question Mr. Jarussi made a video recording of his interview with the witness that he provided to news reporters. It is unclear if Mr. Jarussi also provided the recording to Ms. Karjala's campaign and/or the Neighbors for Responsible Legislators committee.

From the Billings Gazette 10/22/16:

"I can remember being in the old dining hall during lunch and the particulars of the conversation surrounding, I don't remember all that led up to the comment, but he made the statement that 'about 100 years ago, I would have owned you,'" Eskew told Jarussi, who video recorded the conversation.

Ms. Karjala's campaign finance reports do not list any payment to Mr. Jarussi for this service, nor do they report an in-kind contribution from Mr. Jarussi for providing this service. Ms. Karjala's campaign reports do indicate Mr. Jarussi contributed \$170.00 on 6/02/16 (Exhibit 9). (While provided here only for background, considering Mr. Jarussi's status as an attorney and Special Deputy Assistant Attorney General for the State of Montana, the Commissioner should immediately launch an investigation into whether the failure to pay for this service of opposition research and/or report an in-kind contribution is a violation of campaign finance requirements.)

On an unknown date, prior to 10/22/16 Gene Jarussi and Karen Jarussi traveled at their own expense to San Antonio, Texas where they met with yet another former Saunders classmate who had made additional potentially damaging allegations against Saunders. Media reports demonstrate the great lengths to which Mr. Jarussi went to meet with the second potential witness.

From the Billings Gazette 10/22/16:

Jarussi, his wife, Karen, and Eskew met in San Antonio, where the Jarussis were visiting Karen's brother at a managed care facility last month. They had been trying to contact Eskew via Facebook to verify what Lundy had told them.

When they reached Eskew and learned she had a Texas phone number, they called. Eskew's husband is in the military. The couple recently relocated to Texas.

Given that Mr. Jarussi was acting at the specific request and direction of candidate Karjala to conduct opposition research on her opponent, at least a portion of Mr. Jarussi's travel expenses to meet with the potential witness in Texas meet the MCA 13-1-101 definition of a contribution:

(9) (a) "Contribution" means:

(i) the receipt by a candidate or a political committee of an advance, gift, loan, conveyance, deposit, payment, or distribution of money or anything of value to support or oppose a candidate or a ballot issue;

(ii) an expenditure, including an in-kind expenditure, that is made in coordination with a candidate or ballot issue committee and is reportable by the candidate or ballot issue committee as a contribution;

(iii) the receipt by a political committee of funds transferred from another political committee; or

(iv) the payment by a person other than a candidate or political committee of compensation for the personal services of another person that are rendered to a candidate or political committee.

Given that Mrs. Jarussi was at the time both a paid agent of the Karjala campaign and the sole officer of Neighbors for Responsible Legislators committee, the sole purpose of which was to support candidate Karjala and oppose Robert Saunders, at least a portion of Mrs. Jarussi's travel expenses to meet with the potential witness in Texas meet the MCA 13-1-101 definition of a contribution.

Just as in *Ellsworth v Bullock* COPP-2016-CFP where the Commissioner determined that candidate Steve Bullock was required to report his reimbursement of the state for the cost associated with using state aircraft for travel to political meetings and events, so too must the Jarussis report the portion of their travel costs associated with the political meeting(s) taken on behalf of candidate Karjala and/or Neighbors for Responsible Legislators.

These contributions were not reported by the Karjala campaign committee or Neighbors for Responsible Legislators committee, a direct violation of ARM 44.11.402.

The fact that the Jarussis planned this meeting together, traveled together and attended the meeting together in their capacity as agents for the Karjala campaign and the Neighbors for Responsible Legislators committee demonstrates a clear violation of the ARM 44.11.602 prohibition on coordination. Because of the lack of specificity and clarity in campaign finance reporting by both the Karjala campaign and Neighbors for Responsible Legislators committee, it is unclear what other election communications and/or reportable expenditures the work product of this meeting was used in. An investigation and thorough discovery process is warranted to reveal the true level of collusion between the Jarussis, Neighbors for Responsible Legislators and Ms. Karjala.





Republican Robert Saunders is being accused of telling a black college peer at Patrick Henry College that at an earlier point in America's history, he would have owned her. Another peer said Saunders once said President Barack Obama and his family should be "sent back to the fields to pick cotton."

The comments, including a video of Saunders' female accuser, were posted on the Democratic gossip blog Montana Cowgirl.

Through interviews and email inspections, The Gazette confirmed Saunders' classmates were the source of the allegations.

Saunders said there was no truth to the allegations, calling his former classmates not credible.

"At the end of the day, I'm not a racist. I have never been a racist, I will never be a racist," Saunders said. "My relationships with a number of people

will demonstrate that I'm not a racist.”

Patrick Henry College is a Washington, D.C.-area school “founded in 2000 with a vision to restore America by educating the best and brightest Christian students to take their place as future leaders of the nation and its culture,” according to its website. Its alumni are encouraged to run for public office.

But when former classmates Stewart Lundy and Erin Eskew learned of Saunders' campaign to represent north-central Billings in the Montana Legislature, they objected.

Lundy got word to Saunders' opponent, Democratic Rep. Jessica Karjala, that comments allegedly made by Saunders at Patrick Henry deserved looking into. Karjala turned the emails over to attorney Gene Jarussi, who contacted Lundy, who recalled Saunders' making the comments about President Obama.

This year's HD 48 race has been a battle. Last month, Saunders' attorney wrote Karjala a warning letter accusing her of attempting to damage his reputation by suggesting he believes only rich people should vote. The allegation was based on an online survey response Saunders filled out.

Saunders earlier told The Gazette that Karjala is misinterpreting what he wrote. Likewise, Karjala is accusing Saunders of misrepresenting her record by telling constituents she voted to give herself a pay raise, which she didn't.

Speaking to Jarussi, Lundy, a Virginia farmer, also suggested the attorney contact Erin Eskew, one of only a couple of black students in Patrick Henry's student body of 300 during Saunders' time at the school.

Eskew recalled being in dining hall discussion with Saunders during their freshman year in college that ended with a racist remark toward her.

"I can remember being in the old dining hall during lunch and the particulars of the conversation surrounding, I don't remember all that led up to the comment, but he made the statement that 'about 100 years ago, I would have owned you,'" Eskew told Jarussi, who video recorded the conversation.

Jarussi, his wife, Karen, and Eskew met in San Antonio, where the Jarussis were visiting Karen's brother at a managed care facility last month. They had been trying to contact Eskew via Facebook to verify what Lundy had told them.

When they reached Eskew and learned she had a Tennessee phone number, they called. Eskew's husband is in the military. The couple recently relocated to Texas.

Eskew, like many of Patrick Henry's Christian abolitionists, is a Republican. She told The Gazette the choice to come forward wasn't easy, but she reasoned that this year's presidential candidates would be different had the people who knew Hillary Clinton and Donald Trump spoken up years earlier. She said she didn't hate Saunders.

"I don't personally hold any ongoing malice toward him because honestly I feel like racism stems from

either a place of ignorance or malice, and that with either one of those things it's a reflection that there's something going on in his life or his heart that he can't envy," Eskew said.

Eskew said Saunders never apologized for the remarks and that she avoided him for her next three years of school. With only 300 students, Patrick Henry attendees knew each other, knew each other's majors. It was hard not to, Eskew said.

Saunders said he maybe spoke with Eskew once, during freshman orientation, but never again. The conversation Eskew references, never happened, he said.

"I don't know, I really don't know either of these two people. I don't know if I spoke to this Stewart [Eskew]. He was like three years ahead of me," Saunders said. "I met Erin maybe once."

"I don't remember saying that. That's not something I would have said. One hundred years ago would have been 1910. So, I wouldn't have said that. Maybe she misunderstood me. Maybe that's why she happens to hate my guts now, but I wouldn't have said that."
