

I am filing a complaint against Taylor Oldroyd, CEO of the Montana Association of REALTORS (MAR), for failing to disclose MAR staff time spend working to support the Gianforte for Governor campaign, in addition to other legislative races. Taylor Oldroyd directed non-campaign staff to complete these tasks last fall and prior to the election.

In particular, employee MAR employee Kevanne Campbell was directed to assist the Gianforte campaign by obtaining advertising information from newspapers, researching legislation vetoed by Governor Bullock, and assisting in paying campaign bills by helping accounting transfer funds from MAR to the MAR PAC. She was also told to do work for the Stephanie Hess campaign in Havre and for a legislative campaign in Missoula. Her time for this work was not separately recorded and none of it was reported as an in-kind contribution. Other MAR employees were also directed to do unreported work on campaigns last fall.
