Dear Friend:

My name is Janna Taylor, and I'm running for the Montana Senate in the upcoming Republican Primary right here in District 6 where you and I live.

With the June 5 Republican Primary just a few days away, I wanted to take a moment to write you one last time to tell you exactly where I stand on the critical issues facing Montanans -- and to ask for your vote on June 5.

Growing up, my parents instilled in me the values that have helped Montanans thrive for generations: respect for God and fellow man, love of country, hard work, sacrifice, perseverance, honesty . . .

. . . values I'm afraid sometimes get downright forgotten by too many of our politicians.

And whether it's being active in our church, serving as a hospital volunteer -- or in the Montana State House -- I've always done my best to lead by example.

Honestly, the more people I meet, the more I wonder just who the tax-and-spend politicians think they're representing.

Of course, things have gotten better since so many Republicans were ushered into office in 2010.

But Montanans still have to work from January 1 to April 5 every year to pay their federal and state taxes.

And our gas taxes are a whopping 30 cents per gallon -- nearly double the federal rate of 18 cents.

Not only that, but just since Governor Schweitzer took office, state spending has soared by nearly 50%!

It's hard to see how average Montanans have benefited by the enormous ramp up in state spending.

Even Citizens Against Government Waste stated, "When the government is the largest employer in the state, and state agencies are spending \$18 million on travel, Montana taxpayers deserve a smarter, more accountable government."

I agree. And that's what I'll fight for if elected to the State Senate.

Unfortunately, my incumbent opponent has been part of the problem -- not the solution -- during her time in the Montana State Senate.

In fact, just last year, my opponent voted for a bill that could raise taxes by \$2 MILLION per year on hard-working Montanans (Source: S.B. 94, 2011).

Not only that, but she also voted for Montana's very own version of the disastrous Fannie Mae/ Freddie Mac program (Source: S.B. 326, 2011).

Improving standards, fighting for a voucher system and ensuring academics are the focus -- not social indoctrination -- are all steps we can take to make sure our kids get the education they need;

*** Protect our Montana way of life.

That means standing up for our Second Amendment rights, the Right to Life, and our right to religious liberty.

But if I'm going to accomplish any of these things, I'm going to need your vote on June 5.

I hope you agree it's high time we do something to stop abortion here in Montana.



voting to tack on her government mandated training scheme to the Constitutional Carry bill!

Nothing gets my blood boiling as much as politicians playing fast and loose with our constitutionally protected right to keep and bear arms.

And with so much at stake, I'm really going above and beyond to make sure everyone in Montana who cares about the Second Amendment knows exactly where the candidates stand.


