Dear Commissioner:

My name is Rollan Roberts. This is a complaint that Bruce Tutvedt, MT BASE and others violated campaign finance laws during the 2012 primary election. I am filing this complaint reluctantly and after much consideration, and only because of what I consider ongoing false allegations made against me. In fact, as you will see, the very people making allegations against my campaign are the ones violating Montana law.

Unlike his false suppositions I was actually contacted by people within Senator Tutvedt's campaign, and told about these direct and intentional acts to circumvent campaign finance laws. Another reason I reluctantly file this complaint is that these individuals fear reprisals from Bruce Tutvedt. It is my hope that your investigation is confidential and protects them in that regard. To that extent, I bear responsibility for this filing, the information contained in the complaint, and have detailed my contact with callers and contacts as much as I am able.

I feel these intentional acts violate the core values contained in Montana's campaign finance reporting laws, including: taking money from undisclosed parties, coordination with third-party groups, anonymous contributing and spending, receiving corporate contributions, exceeding contribution limits, failing to file

accurate reports, and publicly disclosing who actually paid for their attack ads.

I believe Bruce Tutvedt coordinated, and in fact initiated, attacks during the 2012 primary election. He suggested content and timing of supposed independent expenditures by Montana Business Advocates for Sensible Elections (MT BASE), _____ and an anonymous attack website "Meet the Real Rollan Roberts" by working with them and Charles Denowh, Shelby Meyers and others.

While campaigning I heard on numerous occasions that Bruce was actively encouraging people to engage in campaign attacks against me. This was confirmed when I received a call from someone inside Tutvedt's campaign. I received a call around May 10, 2012 during the early evening. The caller was male. The call lasted approximately 10 to 12 minutes I believe. It was very apparent to me the caller was well acquainted with the inner workings of Tutvedt's campaign based upon our discussion and all that he knew.

The person said that he "felt compelled to tell me about things going on that they knew weren't right". He said, "Bruce Tutvedt had been aggressively trying to get someone to form a PAC to attack me during the final month of the campaign." The caller indicated Bruce was having trouble finding someone. The caller would not give his name because he feared retribution and the number was blocked, but I called some friends with campaign experience to ask if Bruce could do that. I was told he could not, and it was actually against the law. They urged me to file a complaint at that time, but I felt my time was better spent campaigning and talking about issues important to voters. I also spoke with my wife about receiving the call. Shortly after that call, I started noticing the third-party campaign attacks against my campaign. I remember thinking, "Well, he finally found someone."

After Bruce Tutvedt filed a complaint against me, ironically for coordinating with third-party groups, I was told that individuals not openly associated with MT BASE, took full credit for the group's activities. One instance involved state Senator Llew Jones (close friend and supporter of Mr. Tutvedt) who stated that MT BASE had not gone negative against Janna Taylor during the primary. This is telling because mine was the only instance where MT BASE did "go negative" and I believe that was done at the request, suggestion and encouragement of Mr. Tutvedt. Also, at the party caucus following the election I was told Llew Jones projected a computer screen that ~~and~~ had a desktop-type file or icon for "MT BASE."

MT BASE filed as a political committee early in 2012 and was comprised of individuals closely associated Senator Jones. MT BASE was all but dormant and did not even file a report on May 24, 2012 (meaning it had no activity between January and May 19, 2012). Starting May 29th a flurry of activity begins. MT BASE replaces its treasurer, raises thousands of dollars, designs radio ads, mailers and a website, and targets candidates — me included. All of this occurs during a nine day period at the very end of the campaign.

Other Senators who also support Tutvedt, through their business or spouses, appear to have supported MT BASE's efforts in the primary. This includes Jim Peterson, Ed Buttrey and perhaps others. Their

involvement is clearly more extensive than what the reports filed by the group indicate. MT BASE is important enough to take credit for and maintain on computers, but did not warrant so much as an in-kind contribution in the reports. My reading of the law indicates they should have listed their name, rather than businesses or spouses, because in truth they made the contributions to MT BASE. They obviously had some involvement which should have been included in the reports.

After the campaign it was again affirmed to me that Bruce Tutvedt gave Shelby Myers information suggesting attacks. I believe this resulted in mailers, radio ads and the website.

I first heard radio ads on or about and began seeing mailers June 1, 2012. I had seen the website a few days earlier but it was without a disclaimer and anonymous. Even though these attacks specifically targeted me right before the election and presented new issues, I was never provided a copy. That includes MT BASE, their anonymous website—which never did have the required disclaimer.

The campaign's third-party ads take the same approach as the website, and, in fact, share not only common themes but exact language, typesetting, design, mailing, mailing lists, and use pictures from the Tutvedt campaign. Coordinated independent expenditures are actually contributions to the Tutvedt campaign and result in excessive contributions to his campaign.

I reviewed Tutvedt's reports online and saw that he or his third-party supporters reported a substantial amount of primary election spending as late as October. Tutvedt accepted excessive contributions and did not accurately, or timely, file reports in many other respects.

MT BASE began early in 2012, reorganized at the end of May and rapidly began a very aggressive campaign. MT BASE collected over \$11,000 before the primary and spent \$7,500 of it – the majority of which was spent attacking me. MT BASE does not report until after the primary election so it either failed to report activity through May 19th on a report due May 24th or it collected all its money after the period. It is difficult to tell because MT BASE fails to report the dates as required. My search online did not show any C-7 pre-election contribution reports by MT BASE. If this did indeed occur, it is a substantial violation of Montana law in an amount totaling \$11,550. I believe dates may have been intentionally omitted from the C-5 to further conceal the failure to report this activity.

I believe this close coordination and other activity resulted in numerous violations of campaign finance laws, including:

44.10.321 and 323 (administering rules) because Bruce Tutvedt coordinated with third-party groups MT BASE, the anonymous website including supporters Llew Jones, Jim Peterson, BH Ranch Company, Ed Buttrey, treasurers including Fred Rauch II, Chuck Denow and Shelby

Meyers. Mr. Denow and Ms. Meyers at least appear to have a lot of information important to investigating this complaint.

Since coordination destroys the independence of expenditures I believe Bruce Tutvedt, MT BASE, their website, and others did not report, or severely under reported contributions violating 13-37-225 and 13-37-229. To the extent any of these groups or their earmarked contributors involved corporate money, 13-37-227 was violated. Their reports were not true and correct so the treasurers of these groups violated 13-37-231.

As discussed MT BASE did not timely disclose expenditures by waiting until October to include certain expenditures in their C-5 Schedule B. This violates 13-37-230. Their failure to report large corporate and other contributions within 48 hours violates 13-37-229 and the legal timelines established in 13-37-226.

I believe MT BASE took money from people who were not the ones that in truth supplied it-violating 13-37-217.

MT BASE ran radio ads and the disclaimer did not conform to 13-35-225. MT BASE developed/maintained a website attacking me that contained no disclaimer at all which is also a violation of 13-35-225.

B and H Ranch Co. is a person other than an individual and became a political committee under Montana law-13-1-101(22)-and consequently it should have filed reports per 13-37-201 through 231. It failed to.

MT BASE quickly raised and immediately spent \$7,500 on only 3 races all within a week – the majority of which were attacks on me. It seems to me as entirely too coincidental that parties avoided an implication that all or part of the contribution would not go to help in certain elections. That's earmarking money and should have been disclosed in a manner consistent with 13-37-229 and 44.10.519. It was not.

Third-party ads were run in close proximity to the election and in a way that clearly violated 13-35-402.

Thank you for reviewing this complaint. I have attached contact information for various people named as violating laws, or who I think might assist with your investigation.
