

The enclosed campaign flier was recently received by myself and other households in my neighborhood. This is clearly campaign literature from candidate Cleve Loney for his run in House District 21 and after reading the material, I could not find a party affiliation designated therein. In plain language, I believe Montana Law (MCA 13-35-225) requires that all campaign literature must display the candidates party affiliation either by name or symbol, such as the donkey or elephant. I'm concerned that with the changes resulting from the last re-districting and unfamiliarity of the candidates currently running to my area of Cascade County, that the missing party designation will likely prove misleading and troubling to me.

Please consider this my formal complaint against Mr. Loney for distributing campaign literature without listing his party designation. As evidence, I've included the brochure in question as evidence of this violation for your inspection.

Mr. Loney has held office previously and this is his third campaign for the legislature. I can only conclude that this is not a simple oversight, but a clear concealment of his party affiliation. The reasons for this concealment are straightforward as Mr. Loney's involvement in prior campaigns and his active participation in the hierarchy his party's Central Committee belie any claim of ignorance of this requirement.




