

## Statement of Facts

1. Carmine Mowbray's campaign and MT BASE coordinated efforts and both violated 44.10.323, 44.10.321 and contributions were not, therefore, properly reported and violated 13-37-225, 226 and 229. Since coordinated independent expenditures are not expenditures at all but are in-kind contributions, this will cause previously reported independent expenditures and earmarked contributions to MT BASE to exceed contribution limits violating 13-37-216 and 218. In addition to other information contained herein, Jim Simpson- who actively worked on the Mowbray campaign did the voice over for MT-BASE radio spots. (See attached) Carmine Mowbray and MT BASE use the same company, Anderson Broadcasting to do advertisements.
2. Carmine Mowbray accepted a direct contribution from the Confederate Salish & Kootenai Tribes in violated of 13.35.227and 44.10.537. The tribe considers itself a corporation. (See attached) Carmine knows this.
3. Carmine Mowbray improperly deposited money into a Constituency Services Account and illegally transferred and converted that account into her campaign account. This violates 13-37-402, 44.10.335, 44.10.336, 44.10.541, 44.10.542, 44.10.543, and 44.10.544. Since her campaign account is, in fact, her constituency account, all campaign deposits, contributions, and expenditures are illegal.
4. MT BASE did not include a legal disclaimer on radio ads (see attached) and this failed to give Senate District 6 voters notice that MT BASE was an outside, Great Falls, based committee. It also did not include the name of the committee treasurer, Fred Rauch II, who from outside the area, was leading a group to influence one election. This is an egregious violation of 13-37-225. In an effort to further conceal the fact that they were not from the area, MT BASE used local people (Jim and Joann Simpson) to do the ads that MT BASE paid for.
5. MT BASE took contributions in the name of undisclosed principals violating 13-37-217. A person may not make a contribution of the person's own money or of another person's money to any other person in connection with any election in any other name than that of the person who in truth supplies the money.

At a minimum, if people who were also on accounts directed or encouraged contributions to MT BASE those individuals should have been disclosed. If they were, in truth, the person with the primary interest in the making of the contribution their name should have been reported not their spouse of company.

On at least a few occasions I had indications that some of the contributors to MT BASE were not the persons who, in truth, supplied the money.

At a dinner I had following the primary with Llew Jones, Ed Buttrey, Carol Jones, and another gentlemen, Llew explained that while MT BASE supported Carmine “they” did not “go negative” on me. Nobody refuted that. At the party caucus following the general election Llew repeated that statement.

Also, shortly after the primary, my friend, Karen Hollandsworth, hugged and congratulated me on winning. It was apparent to me from our conversation she had no idea that she contributed \$2,000 to a group (MT-BASE) who tried to defeat me.

B&H Ranch Co of 501 Peterson Ranch Lane in Buffalo, MT contributed \$2,000 is Jim Peterson’s Ranch. If he in truth is supplying and the money he should be named. He was not named. Also, the expenditures made by MT BASE seem to be ones made to encourage avoiding making contributions in violation of 44-10-517.

6. Jim Peterson’s company became a political committee itself when it contributed money to MT BASE. It did not file any required reports and violated several laws including 13-37-201, 208, 216, 218, 225, 226, 228, 230, and 231.
7. Carmine Mowbray did email blasts throughout the campaign and MT Hunters and Anglers distributed material within 10 days of the election. To the extent these materials contained issues not previously discussed in the campaign violated 13-35-402.
8. Also, MT BASE violated several Montana reporting laws in their initial report for activity conducted between May 25, 2012 (when they started) and the post election report of June 20, 2012 and filed June 25<sup>th</sup> of the same year. They do not contain all the necessary information such as the date received. Their later reports show reporting deficiencies when they report primary election activity, reporting months late in many instances.

In conclusion, I would like to point out that an attempt is a violation of the law (13-35-104) and that aiding and abetting violations is also, itself, a violation of Montana Campaign Finance laws.. (see 13-35-105).

Kootenai Tribes for operating expenses. \$1,700,453 was paid to CSKT through S&K Gaming's gaming revenue, which exceeded the projected dividend of \$1.5 million.

The Agents took action this year to award student scholarships. The Tribal Education Department formed a committee to score the applicants. On August 8, 2011, the LLC named John Whitworth and Kenneth Barnaby as the 2011 recipients of the scholarships and they were each awarded \$2,500.

During peak season, the workforce is comprised of 143 employees. As of September 30, 2011, 61 percent of the workforce was comprised of enrolled CSKT tribal members. Sheila Matt was appointed as Acting Principal Operations Officer on January 7, 2011.

In 2011, the KwaTaqNuk Casino expanded to maximize gaming revenues and opportunities. S&K Gaming borrowed \$600,000 from the Tribes for this expansion and makes monthly payments on the loan. The expansion made room for 282 gaming machines, provided The People's Center display space for cultural items, and included the addition of a business center. The KwaTaqNuk recently opened a restaurant, "The Nook," which provides breakfast, lunch and dinner.

### **S&K Holding Company**

S&K Holding Company conducts economic development projects for CSKT, which owns the for-profit business that was created in 1992. The company manages various projects including Boulder Hydro, S&K Self Storage and Flathead Botanicals. SKHC also manages two tribal properties in Polson. Overall, SKHC had a successful 2011. Gross Revenue was \$212,599. This was primarily a result of \$72,000 from Sovereign Leasing & Financing for management services; \$47,000 from Boulder Hydro power and REC sales; \$27,000 from Self Storage revenue, \$38,000 from the Tribes EDA Grant; and almost \$18,000 in lease revenue.

### **S&K Technologies, Inc.**

S&K Technologies (SKT) is a family of companies owned by the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes. In the past six years, SKT has grown considerably in size, consisting of several subsidiary companies

known as LLC's. These companies offer information technology, engineering, and aerospace services to a variety of Federal government and commercial customers. The companies maintain offices throughout the United States and work on a wide-range of projects that include Uranium Mill Tailings Remediation for the US Department of Energy, and telephony services to various commercial customers. SKT (the parent company) is located in St. Ignatius and offers streamlined administrative services to the subsidiary companies, allowing them to reduce costs and be more competitive.

## **Eagle Bank**

Eagle Bank was chartered in July 2006, and is truly a "Community Owned Bank" with its ownership held on behalf of the approximately 7,800 members of the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes of the Flathead Nation. Eagle Bank is one of only nine banks that are owned by a Native American Tribe and the only bank with its holding company organized under Section 17 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934. The bank continues to grow at a conservative rate with total assets increasing to \$30 million by year end and completed its second year of profitability in very trying economic times.

As of December 31, 2011 the bank serviced 1,058 deposits accounts with total deposits of \$26 million and 695 loan accounts with loans totaling \$12.1 million.

Eagle Bank is located at the intersection of Highway 35 and Heritage Lane in Polson and operates an ATM at the Quick Silver convenience store in Pablo.

## **Mission Valley Power**

Mission Valley Power experienced an exceptional year in FY 2011. MVP employs 82 people and total revenue were \$23,047,692. MVP manages 19,000 meters and an estimated 20,000-plus people obtain their power from the tribally-managed federal facility. South Shore and Kerr substations had large new transformers installed and energized and 25 miles of power line were rebuilt to assure power delivery. Since 2009, nine employees have gained journeymen status, a title earned from additional schooling and on-the-job experience.

In 2011, the non-profit organization managed the end of a 10-year contract with their main power supplier, Bonneville Power Administration. MVP moved into a new era of power purchasing whereby BPA, which once provided unlimited power, will now allocate a block of power, but if usage exceeds that set amount, MVP will likely need to go on the open market to meet additional usage.

A five-member Utility Board provides direction to the general manager as well as overall policy guidance and system planning. The

Utility Board is appointed by Tribal Council. A seven-member Consumer Council provides the consumer an opportunity for participating in the development of policies by management. Each member of Consumer Council is appointed by the BIA superintendent. Two represent Lake County, one Sanders County, one Missoula County, and three are members-at-large. At least one appointee, but no more than two appointees, shall be enrolled Tribal members.

## **S&K Electronics**

S&K Electronics remains a lead High Tech manufacturer in Indian Country. S&K Electronics, which is based in Pablo, had another good year with more than \$17 million in sales, and our sixth straight year in the black. PRIDE IN PRECISION, the company motto, speaks to the highly-trained workforce and the pride exhibited in the work they do. Our values helped us maintain sales, profitability, and a productive workforce in a highly competitive industry. S&K Electronics continually invests in new leading technologies, employee training, customer service, and the latest manufacturing processes to grow further sales and profitability for the future, which provides dividends to our Tribal shareholder.

## **S&K Gaming LLC**

The Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes formed S&K Gaming Limited Liability Company on August 3, 2006, pursuant to Ordinance 104A, for the purpose of providing general gaming management oversight to the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes. S&K Gaming Limited Liability Company is managed by three Agents of the LLC. The Agents are Tribal Council members Jim Malatare, Reuben Mathias and James V. (Bing) Matt.

S&K Gaming's mission is to deliver outstanding customer service in a professional atmosphere that promotes financial and regulatory integrity, overall profitability, tribal member employment and community involvement while contributing to the economic vitality of the Flathead Reservation.

S&K Gaming's net revenue was nearly \$5 million. Since January 2010, S&K Gaming has been operating as a self-reliant business, which means no money has been borrowed from the Confederated Salish and

**TO THE SALISH, KOOTENAI, AND PEND D'OREILLE PEOPLE,**

Welcome to another Annual Report from our government. Here you will find an explanation of the many complex departments that provide service and support to our Tribal members. This report is a snapshot to show the hard work that goes on every day in our Tribal buildings. As a sovereign Nation, we're on a path toward some important and challenging tasks. Your Tribal Council is taking necessary steps to serve our members well. The Council is a team, and we are all proud of the hard work and dedication shown by our workers every day.

Two of our biggest challenges surround the efforts to purchase and operate the Kerr Dam Complex in 2015. We've been planning for this project for years. It's a complicated issue in terms of staffing and training logistics. The lease payments are a steady source of Tribal income, but when we purchase and operate the facility, our investment will pay greater returns. The other big challenge is the on-going water rights talks with the Montana Reserved Water Rights Compact Commission. We're confident the negotiations will continue to go well until completion. Our successful negotiations will have a positive impact on our people for many generations into the future.

Already this year, Council has met with the Governor of Montana and discussed the most pressing issues for our people. Our daily job involves regular contact with state legislators and federal Congressionals. We have many success stories to share with them, including the continued success of S&K Electronics and S&K Technologies. Our gaming operations in Polson and Evaro are still going strong despite the challenging economic climate. Our Education department is going through a multiple-level review and assessment to improve the entire education system, from early head start to the attainment of advanced college degrees. Another bright note to mention is that Forestry is seeing a recovery in timber prices and the CSKT forestry nursery program is thriving. The program has grown native plants for the Opportunity Ponds superfund site, US Highway 93 re-vegetation, Flathead National Forest, along with the Rocky Boy and Blackfeet Indian Reservations. About 70 tribal member hires helped in the planting efforts of 3,000 acres in the Lozeau Special Use Area, which is a result of the Chippy Creek fire.


The Tribe also continues management of the southern half of Flathead Lake by ensuring managers focus on what's best for the lake. We'll continue our community boards at Mission Valley Power and for our wildlife management efforts. We'll continue to help everyone's safety by remaining first responders on 911 calls with our law enforcement team. We'll keep supporting good community ideas that impact all residents, and we'll keep trying to educate people further about our history here, our connection to this reservation and the surrounding aboriginal territories, and mostly, we'll remain good neighbors as we all work to preserve our heritage.

This spring, we will have a new Tribal Health building in Polson, which will provide a higher level of service to the Indian populations.
