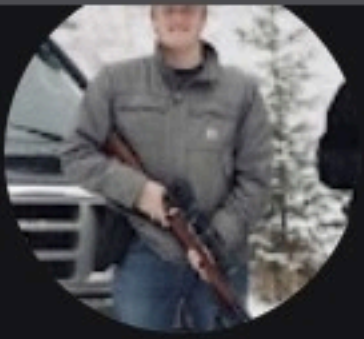
I have also attached an image of the fourth flyer, which we corrected before it went out today. We fixed it this morning prior to distribution.
