- 10 posters (24"x18")

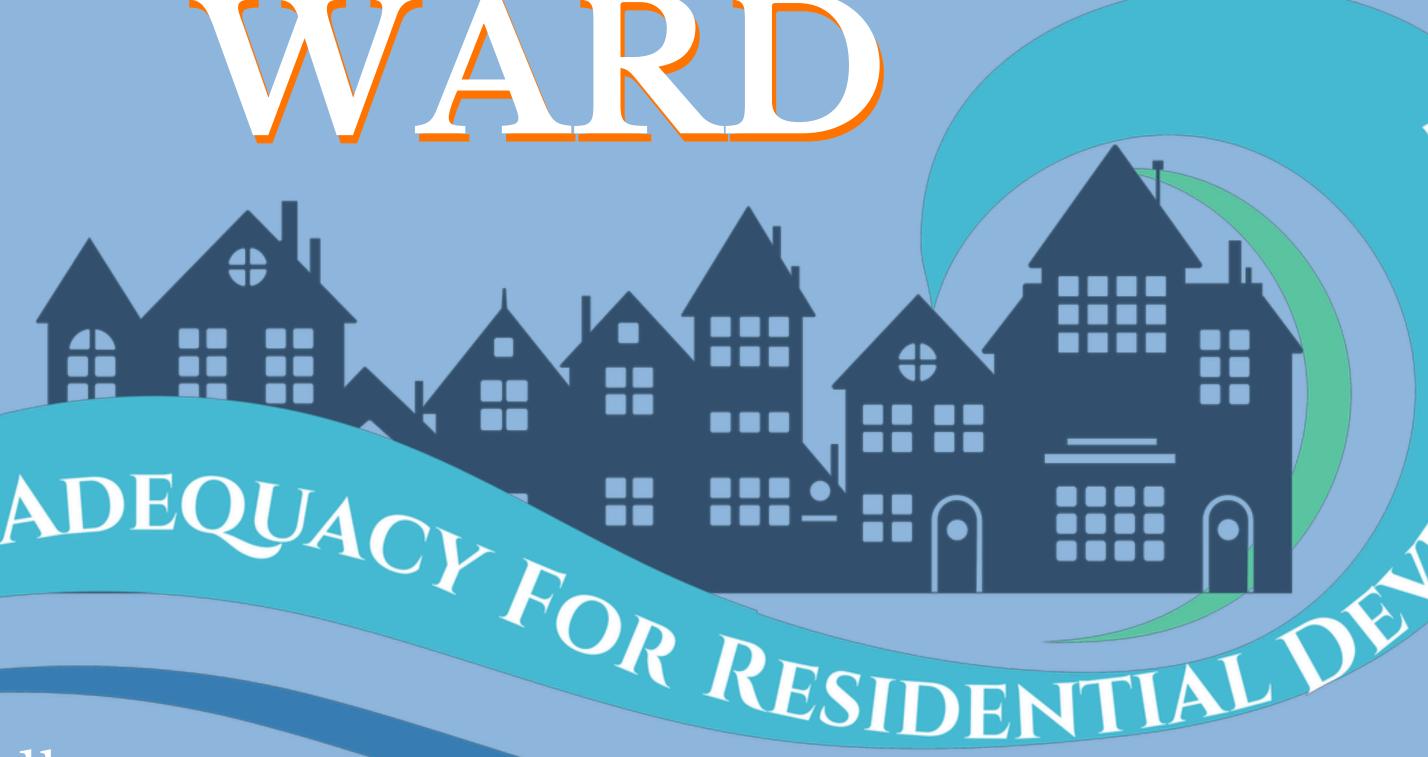

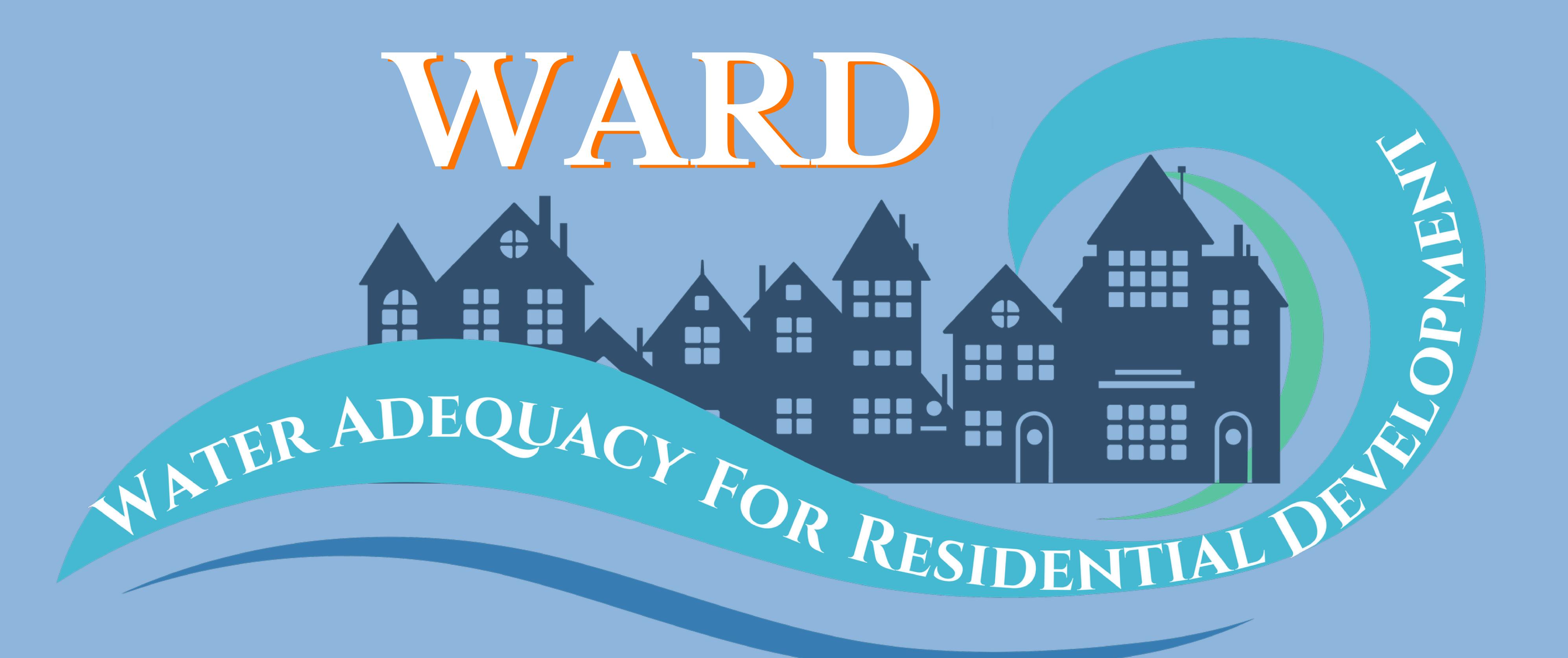

## The Water Adequacy initiative (WARD) will:

- Give you, **Bozeman residents, a voice** in how our finite water supply is allocated in new residential developments.
- Require new residential developments that pay cash-in-lieu
  of water rights to include 33% affordable units for rent at
  60% Area Median Income (AMI) or for sale at 120% AMI.
- Require the affordable units to be the **same quality and size** as those rented or sold at market rate.
- **Distribute affordable units evenly** within a development and allocate those units to qualified Bozeman residents by random lottery.
- Deed-restrict all affordable units for 99 years or as long as the law allows.
