Candidate Theresa Manzella Campaign Finance and Practices Complaint

Candidate Theresa Manzella has violated Montana campaign law, specifically 13-37-201 MCA which requires a candidate to appoint and certify a campaign treasurer and file the certification with the Commissioner of Political Practices within 5 days of becoming a candidate.

Candidate Manzella has also violated 13-27-225 MCA which requires candidates to file periodic electronic reports of contributions and expenditures with the commissioner on specific calendar dates that correspond with the filing requirements of 13-37-226 MCA.

The C-1 and C-5 reports filed by candidate Manzella show a history of unreported expenditures going back to her initial entry into Montana politics in 2013. While the statute of limitations precludes investigation into one of her most flagrant violations in 2013, I am including it here as it shows a pattern of blatant disregard for Montana's campaign finance laws.

Candidate Manzella has run for legislative office 3 times previously and should be well versed in Montana's campaign finance laws, the most basic of which is to declare candidacy and report campaign expenditures and donations within specific deadlines.

Candidate Manzella's failure to file the proper candidate registration and finance reports was particularly harmful to potential candidates who were considering running for House District 85 if she were to abandon her House seat to run for the Senate, which she ultimately did.

I would ask that you direct candidate Manzella to take the necessary steps to immediately report all of her unreported expenses. Additionally, because she has demonstrated a long history of skirting the law, I ask that you investigate her bank statements, receipts and donor statements to assure the citizens of Montana that she has not further violated the spirit of transparency embodied in Montana's campaign finance laws.

Specific violations are described below:

2020 Election

 Candidate Manzella became a candidate on May 17, 2019 when she accepted money for her "Senatorial campaign" during a meeting of the Bitterroot North Valley Pachyderm club per 13-1-101(8)(b) and 9(a) MCA.

As a candidate, Rep. Manzella was required to assign a treasurer and file with the Commissioner of Political Practices withing 5 days after becoming a candidate per 13-37-201 MCA, which she did not do until July 31, 2019, 74 days after becoming a candidate.

She was also required to file with the commissioner by July 5, 2019, a report of contributions and expenditures made during the time period of April 1, 2019 – June

30, 2019 per 13-37-226 MCA. She failed to file the required financial report until October 4, 2019, 105 days after the report was due.

Several expenditures were not reported by the required reporting deadline and have not been reported on any campaign report to date:

- a. Candidate Manzella advertised a "Constitution Day" event on 9/17/19. She paid for the invitations out of her campaign account and reported the expense as required but did not report the expense for "snacks and refreshments" offered in the invitation. (see screenshot 2020 1a)
- b. Candidate Manzella reported an expense for "Stickers to cover HD85 on old signs" but did not report the quantity of stickers nor did she report any old signs as an in-kind donation.
- c. Candidate Manzella reported an expense for "repair and replacement of lights on billboard that <u>I'm renting</u> for campaign sign" but she did not report the rental expense for the billboard or the power bill for the lights. (see screenshot 2020 1c -1)
 - A second billboard, south of Hamilton, the rental expense has not been reported. (see screenshot 2020 1c-2)
- d. Candidate Manzella placed a custom campaign logo wrap on the tailgate of her truck. The expense was not reported. (see screenshot 2020 1d)
- e. Candidate Manzella displayed 2-4'x8' printed "voting record" campaign signs in the district. The signs are not reported as either expenses or in-kind donations. (see screenshot 2020 1e)
- f. Candidate Manzella advertised "chances to win a rifle in exchange for sign locations" but she did not report the "chances to win" as items of value exchanged for "paid for sign locations". Nor has she reported the expense for the Henry Big Boy rifle being "given away", nor has she reported any expenses for "raffle tickets" or any accounting of the persons to whom "raffle tickets" were given.
 - Clearly sign locations are not normally reported as "anything of value" but candidate Manzella seems to assign value to the sign locations as she offers to "buy" them in exchange for items of value, i.e. the "chances to win a rifle". I would expect to see, at the very least, an in-kind reporting of the exchange. The fair market value for gun raffle tickets in Republican fundraising campaigns over the past few years has been well established at \$5 per ticket. "Buying" sign locations with gifts of raffle tickets may not be illegal but it certainly seems like something the public should know. Candidate Manzella should be required to report each of her "gifts" of raffle tickets as a campaign expense. (see screenshots 2020 1f and you tube video referenced in screenshot)
- g. Near the end of April 2020, Candidate Manzella placed U.S. flags and Montana flags on many of her large signs around the county. Purchase of the flags has not been reported. (see screenshot 2020 1g)

- h. Candidate Manzella displays several large banners on her wagon or freestanding but there is no reporting of these banners as a campaign expense. (see screenshot 2020 1i)
- Candidate Manzella advertised a Victory Party to be held on June 20, 2020.
 No expenses have been reported for this event. (see screenshot 20201j)
- j. Candidate Manzella advertised a Fundraiser to be held on August 14, 2020. She reported approximately 100 people in attendance. She has not reported any expenses related to this fundraiser event. Because donation dates are not shown on the Finance Report, it is not clear whether she reported any donations received at this fundraiser event. (see screenshot 2020 1k)

2018 Election

- Candidate Manzella posted a photo on facebook on 9/27/18 of herself installing one of 2 specialized 4'x8' voter "scorecard" signs but she did not report any expense for the signs. (see screenshot 2018 1)
- Candidate Manzella installed several campaign signs around her district but did not report any expense or in-kind donation of the signs. (see screenshot 2018 2)
- 3. Candidate Manzella paid Jim Burrill \$200 on 11/26/18 for "payment for help setting up and tearing down signs". On 7/30/19, candidate Manzella amended her financial report with another payment of \$200 to her friend, Jim Burrill for "help with signs". It is not clear why a portion of the excess campaign funds candidate Manzella reported on her 11/26/18 report was reported 8 months later for what appears to be another \$200 payment to her friend.

2014 Election (the statute of limitation has run on this violation but it is important to note as it is the first Montana campaign in which candidate Manzella participated and marks the beginning of her failure to report required expenditures and/or donations.

In October of 2013, candidate Manzella's first campaign, she advertised a
"Fundraising Horsemanship Clinic" on Oct 12, 2013 for \$100 including a sirloin
steak and training. 21 people reported on facebook that they went to the clinic
yet no expenses or donations were reported on candidate Manzella's financial
reports for the 2014 election. (see screenshots 2014)
