Good afternoon,

Please see the attached pictures of the postcard mailer in question which did include a full attribution as required per MCA 13-35-225(1) and (2). The extremely low quality black and white copies provided by the complainant do not depict the attribution, however, it is in fact present and legible for any individual who makes a reasonable attempt to discern the source.

Due to a design/production oversight the attribution is not as prominent as originally intended. The text was moved from the white field it usually sits on by the designer as there was a footnote section in that area. On a backlit screen during design the attribution is more prominent, however, in offsite production/print the background color resulted in a darker appearance than desired. Regardless, the attribution is present and legible with what I believe to be a reasonable degree of prominence. Future postcards will be adjusted with higher contrast placement. Please advise as to whether or not I am still required to provide the additional information (numbers of materials, dates etc.) as the claims in this complaint is based on appear to be flawed.
