Mr. Cook,

Thank you for reviewing my response to the complaint lodged by Mr. O'Neill.

The C-5 filed by my campaign treasurer for the period 04/16/2024 through 05/14/2024 disclosed my cash expenses for that period, including the expenditure for attending the Broadwater County Lincoln Reagan dinner held in Townsend on 04/20/2024, but it combined that cash expense (\$40) with the other cash expenses (totaling \$167.10) that I incurred and which were provided to my treasurer for that period. My treasurer will be filing immediately an amended C-5 for the period setting out the cash expenditures individually.

Additionally, while I provided my campaign treasurer with the mileage expenditures for the reporting period, the C-5 as originally filed omitted these mileage entries. The amended C-5 describes the individual trips taken and the mileage entry for each trip during the reporting period, including the mileage expenditure for attending the event in Townsend on April 20.

You will find these corrected entries under the Debts portion of the amended C-5 filing. This should clear up any confusion in the filings and provide an adequate accounting and report of the expenditures at issue.
