Guide to registering electronically as a Lobbyist using the Principal and Lobbyist

Online Reporting System


What is a lobbyist? A lobbyist is a person engaging in the practice of lobbying. Lobbyists must register with COPP if paid \$3,000.00 or more to lobby.

How to Register Electronically:


1: From the Commissioner of Political Practice's website, click the 'Principal and Lobbyist Online Reporting System' link.



<u>2</u>: From the Principal and Lobbyist Online Reporting System homepage, click the 'Login as Lobbyist' icon.



3: Login, via Okta. Users may utilize an existing Okta login.



- 4: Logging in with Okta will take you to the Lobbyists page.
 - If the lobbyist has received an email from the Principal and Lobbyist Online Reporting System asking them to acknowledge an application to represent a specific principal, they will be sent an Access ID generated by the system. Under 'Access for Existing Lobbyists', enter the Access ID in the 'Access ID' tab, then click the 'Register Lobbyist' icon.



• To register as a lobbyist for the first time, under 'Lobbyists that have never Registered' click the 'Register New Lobbyist' icon.
