Build Montana aka Build Montana PAC has violated MCA 13-37-210 by failing to name and identify itself in its organizational statement using a name or phrase that clearly identifies the economic interest and shared common employer of the majority of its contributors.

MCA 13-37-210 states:

Naming and labeling of political committees. (1) Any political committee filing a certification and organizational statement pursuant to 13-37-201 shall:

- (a) name and identify itself in its organizational statement using a name or phrase:
- (i) that clearly identifies the economic or other special interest, if identifiable, of a majority of its contributors; and
- (ii) if a majority of its contributors share a common employer, that identifies the employer; and
- (b) label any media advertisement or other paid public statement it makes or causes to be made in support of or opposition to any candidate or ballot issue by printing or broadcasting its name, as provided under subsection (1)(a), and position in support of or opposition to the candidate or ballot issue as a part of the media advertisement or other paid public statement.
- (2) The naming and labeling requirements in subsection (1) are reporting requirements for purposes of enforcement under <u>13-37-128</u>

Build Montana PAC filed an amended C-2 Statement of Organization with the Commissioner's office on 10/21/2016 (Exhibit 1). A search of both the electronic filings and the hard copy filings on the CoPP website shows the committee has filed 4 C-6 campaign finance reports covering: 3/29-4/27/2016, 7/29-8/27/2016, 8/28-9/26/2016, 9/27-10/19/2016 (Exhibit 2-5)

1. Violation MCA 13-37-210(A)(i)

The: 3/29-4/27/2016 (Exhibit 2) report lists 1 contributor

Special Leg PAC - in-kind of \$7,768.86

With only one contributor there is no doubt of its common economic or special interest as a political committee associated with a labor union. The failure to include a reference to the common economic or special interest of the committees single contributor in its name is a clear violation of MCA 13-27-210(A)(ii) that requires committees to use a name or phrase that identifies shared economic or special interest of a majority of its contributors.

MCA 13-37-201(B)(2) allows for enforcement under MCA 13-37-128

MCA 13-37-128 States:

Cause of action created. (1) A person who intentionally or negligently violates any of the reporting provisions of this chapter, a provision of <u>13-35-225</u>, or a provision of Title 13, chapter 35, part 4, is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant

to the provisions outlined in $\underline{13-37-124}$ and $\underline{13-37-125}$ for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater.

(2) A person who makes or receives a contribution or expenditure in violation of <u>13-35-227</u>, <u>13-35-228</u>, or this chapter or who violates <u>13-35-226</u> is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in <u>13-37-124</u> and <u>13-37-125</u> for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contribution or expenditure, whichever is greater.

2. Violation MCA 13-37-210(A)(i)

The: 7/29-8/27/2016 (Exhibit 3) report lists 3 contributors

Montana State AFL-CIO - in-kind of \$2,568.49

International Association of Fire Fighters – \$25,000.00

Union of Operating Engineers - \$50,000.00

With 3 contributors all of which are labor unions or political committees associated with labor unions there is no doubt of its common economic or special interest of labor unions. The failure to include a reference to the common economic or special interest of the committees single contributor in its name is a clear violation of MCA 13-27-210(A)(ii) that requires committees to use a name or phrase that identifies shared economic or special interest of a majority of its contributors.

MCA 13-37-201(B)(2) allows for enforcement under MCA 13-37-128

MCA 13-37-128 States:

Cause of action created. (1) A person who intentionally or negligently violates any of the reporting provisions of this chapter, a provision of $\underline{13-35-225}$, or a provision of Title 13, chapter 35, part 4, is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in $\underline{13-37-124}$ and $\underline{13-37-125}$ for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater.

(2) A person who makes or receives a contribution or expenditure in violation of $\underline{13-35-227}$, $\underline{13-35-228}$, or this chapter or who violates $\underline{13-35-226}$ is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in $\underline{13-37-124}$ and $\underline{13-37-125}$ for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contribution or expenditure, whichever is greater.

3. Violation MCA 13-37-210(A)(i)

The: 8/28-9/26/2016 (Exhibit 4) report lists 1 contributor

Montana State AFL-CIO - in-kind of \$2,763.56

With only one contributor there is no doubt of its common economic or special interest of a labor unions. The failure to include a reference to the common economic or special interest of the

committees single contributor in its name is a clear violation of MCA 13-27-210(A)(ii) that requires committees to use a name or phrase that identifies shared economic or special interest of a majority of its contributors.

MCA 13-37-201(B)(2) allows for enforcement under MCA 13-37-128

MCA 13-37-128 States:

Cause of action created. (1) A person who intentionally or negligently violates any of the reporting provisions of this chapter, a provision of $\underline{13-35-225}$, or a provision of Title 13, chapter 35, part 4, is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in $\underline{13-37-124}$ and $\underline{13-37-125}$ for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater.

(2) A person who makes or receives a contribution or expenditure in violation of $\underline{13-35-227}$, $\underline{13-35-228}$, or this chapter or who violates $\underline{13-35-226}$ is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in $\underline{13-37-124}$ and $\underline{13-37-125}$ for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contribution or expenditure, whichever is greater.

4. Violation MCA 13-37-210(A)(i)

The: 9/27-10/19/2016 (Exhibit 5) report lists 5 contributors

American Federation of Teachers - \$50,000.00

Machinists Non-Partisan Political League Committee - \$25,000.00

Montana State AFL-CIO - in-kind of \$133,525.50

Professional Fire Fighters of Idaho - \$1,000.00

SEIU Healthcare - \$20,000.00

With 5 contributors all of which are labor unions or political committees associated with labor unions there is no doubt of its common economic or special interest of labor unions. The failure to include a reference to the common economic or special interest of the committees single contributor in its name is a clear violation of MCA 13-27-210(A)(ii) that requires committees to use a name or phrase that identifies shared economic or special interest of a majority of its contributors.

MCA 13-37-201(B)(2) allows for enforcement under MCA 13-37-128

MCA 13-37-128 States:

Cause of action created. (1) A person who intentionally or negligently violates any of the reporting provisions of this chapter, a provision of $\underline{13-35-225}$, or a provision of Title 13, chapter 35, part 4, is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in $\underline{13-37-124}$ and $\underline{13-37-125}$ for an amount up to \$500 or three times

the amount of the unlawful contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater.

(2) A person who makes or receives a contribution or expenditure in violation of <u>13-35-227</u>, <u>13-35-228</u>, or this chapter or who violates <u>13-35-226</u> is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in <u>13-37-124</u> and <u>13-37-125</u> for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contribution or expenditure, whichever is greater.

Build Montana aka Build Montana PAC has violated MCA 13-35-225(1)(B) by distributing election materials without a proper disclaimer/attribution.

MCA 13-35-225 states:

Election materials not to be anonymous -- statement of accuracy -- notice -- penalty. (1) All election communications, electioneering communications, and independent expenditures must clearly and conspicuously include the attribution "paid for by" followed by the name and address of the person who made or financed the expenditure for the communication. The attribution must contain:

- (a) for election communications or electioneering communications financed by a candidate or a candidate's campaign finances, the name and the address of the candidate or the candidate's campaign;
- (b) for election communications, electioneering communications, or independent expenditures financed by a political committee, the name of the committee, the name of the committee treasurer, and the address of the committee or the committee treasurer; and

5. Violation MCA 13-35-225 (1)(B)

On or before 10/25/2016 Build Montana aka Build Montana PAC distributed a campaign mailing opposing Greg Gianforte and supporting Steve Bullock (Exhibit 6). The disclaimer lists the committee name and committee treasurer but does not list the committee address as required by statute.

MCA 13-35-225(7)(b) allows for enforcement under MCA 13-37-128

MCA 13-37-128 States:

Cause of action created. (1) A person who intentionally or negligently violates any of the reporting provisions of this chapter, a provision of $\underline{13-35-225}$, or a provision of Title 13, chapter 35, part 4, is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in $\underline{13-37-124}$ and $\underline{13-37-125}$ for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater.

(2) A person who makes or receives a contribution or expenditure in violation of $\underline{13-35-227}$, $\underline{13-35-228}$, or this chapter or who violates $\underline{13-35-226}$ is liable in a civil action brought by the commissioner or a county attorney pursuant to the provisions outlined in $\underline{13-37-124}$ and $\underline{13-37-125}$ for an amount up to \$500 or three times the amount of the unlawful contribution or expenditure, whichever is greater.

Build Montana aka Build Montana PAC has violated ARM 44.11.201(1)(F) by distributing election materials that oppose Candidate for Governor Greg Gianforte and failing to list that mission in its C-2 form.

ARM 44.11.201 states:

STATEMENT OF ORGANIZATION - POLITICAL COMMITTEE, INFORMATION REQUIRED

- (1) A statement of organization required to be filed pursuant to 13-37-201 and 13-37-205, MCA, shall include, but not be limited to:
- (a) The complete name and address of a political committee.
- (b) The complete names and address of all related or affiliated political committees, and the nature of the relationship or affiliation.
- (c) The complete name and address of its campaign treasurer and campaign depository, and the complete name and address of its deputy campaign treasurer and secondary campaign depository, if any.
- (d) The complete names, addresses, and titles of its officers, if any.
- (e) A statement of whether a committee is incorporated.
- (f) The name, office sought, and party affiliation (if any) of each candidate on whom the committee makes a reportable election expenditure, or if a committee is supporting the entire ticket of any party, the name of the party.
- (g) Ballot issue or issues concerned, if any, and whether a committee is in favor of or opposes such issue or issues.

6. Violation ARM 44.11.201(1)(F)

Build Montana aka Build Montana PAC filed an amended C-2 form on 10/21/2016 (Exhibit 1) listing support of 3 statewide candidates and opposition of 1 ballot measure.

As referenced in Violation # 5, On or before 10/25/2016 Build Montana aka Build Montana PAC distributed a campaign mailing opposing Greg Gianforte and supporting Steve Bullock (Exhibit 6).

The failure to properly list "The name, office sought, and party affiliation (if any) of each candidate on whom the committee makes a reportable election expenditure" of candidate Gianforte is a clear violation of this administrative rule.

Build Montana aka Build Montana PAC has violated ARM 44.11.502(7) failing to report the purpose and quantity of election materials.

ARM 44.11.502 states:

EXPENDITURES, REPORTING

- (1) A campaign expense paid personally by an individual in his or her own campaign is always coordinated with, and is a campaign expense of, the campaign that must be reported and disclosed as an expense by the campaign in the same manner as an expense paid through the campaign depository account.
- (2) An obligation to pay for a campaign expenditure is incurred on the date the obligation is made, and shall be reported as a debt of the campaign until the campaign pays the obligation by making an expenditure.
- (3) An expenditure is made on the date payment is made, or in the case of an in-kind expenditure, on the date the consideration is given.
- (4) The date of each expenditure shall be reported in the reporting period during which it is made.
- (5) Expenditures made from the petty cash fund need not be reported, except that an accounting shall be maintained pursuant to ARM 44.11.409.
- (6) All expenditures must be supported by a contemporaneous written agreement, invoice, billing statement, or similar documentation appropriate to the transaction that describes the services provided, the billing period identifying the specific dates on which services were provided, an itemized basis for the payments made, and other pertinent information.
- (7) For purposes of the disclosure requirements of 13-37-229 and 13-37-232, MCA, the "purpose" of each expenditure as reported on the commissioner's campaign finance reporting forms shall specifically describe the purpose, quantity, subject matter, as appropriate to each expenditure, and must be detailed enough to distinguish among expenditures for similar purposes. For example, two expenditures for direct mail advertisements should not both be reported as "Flyers."

7. <u>Violation ARM 44.11.501(7)</u>

The: 9/27/16-10/19/2016 (Exhibit 5) c6 report lists a \$58,000 payment to JVA Campaigns of Columbus, Ohio on 10/19/2016 that is described only as "Payment for Campaign mailings/Governor Bullock" this description does not comply with the standards set forth in this ARM.

8. <u>Violation ARM 44.11.501(7)</u>

The: 9/27/16-10/19/16 (Exhibit 5) c6 report lists a \$21,679.88 payment to JVA Campaigns of Columbus, Ohio on 10/17/2016 that is described only as "Payment for Campaign mailings/Vote by Mail Piece/HD 22, HD 60 mailers" this description does not comply with the standards set forth in this ARM.

9. Violation ARM 44.11.501(7)

The: 9/27/16-10/19/16 (Exhibit 5) c6 report lists a \$10,285.73 payment to JVA Campaigns of Columbus, Ohio on 10/03/2016 that is described only as "Payment for Campaign for Voter by mail mailings" this description does not comply with the standards set forth in this ARM.

10. Violation ARM 44.11.501(7)

The: 9/27/16-10/19/16 (Exhibit 5) c6 report lists a \$8,321.04 payment to JVA Campaigns of Columbus, Ohio on 9/28/2016 that is described only as "Payment for Campaign mailings for Voter by Mail application mailer" this description does not comply with the standards set forth in this ARM.

This is obviously an orchestrated effort by State and National Labor Unions to mount a negative campaign while concealing the true source of funds attempting to hide their efforts through vague reporting. This pattern of severe disregard for Montana's campaign finance and reporting requirements demands severe consequences.


