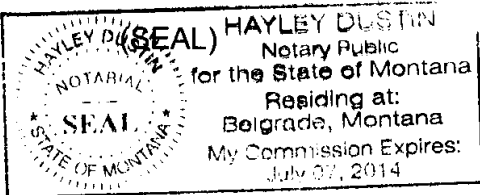

Once the commissioner investigates the Peterson and Wilks complaint, he will have evidence establishing that Jim Peterson personally handed out envelopes with four checks inside, one each from Dan Wilks, Staci Wilks, Farris Wilks, and Joann Wilks to various candidates including candidate Ankney.

A political committee is defined at section 13-1-101(22), MCA, as a combination of two or more individuals who contribute to support a candidate. The circumstances surrounding delivery of the checks, by Peterson from four separate individuals, evidences the fact there was a combination of two or more individuals who contributed to support candidate Ankney.

Political committees, such as Peterson/Wilks Committee, are subject to contribution limits as set forth in section 13-37-216, MCA, and ARM 44.10.331. In 2012, contribution limits to a legislative candidate was \$160 per election. Peterson/Wilks Committee contributed \$640 (\$160 each from Dan Wilks, Staci Wilks, Farris Wilks, and Joann Wilks) to Ankney for his 2012 general election, \$480 over the limit. See October 2012 campaign finance report on file with Commissioner's office.

Candidate Ankney knew, or should have known, the contribution was coming from a political committee and was an excess contribution. Ignorance of the law is not an excuse for violating the law. Ankney is again a candidate in 2014. The Commissioner must find that Ankney violated campaign finance laws in 2012; remove him from office; and hold his name off the ballot for the 2014 primary election.
