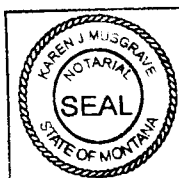

I just wanted to touch base with you over the crazy allegations that were made in this week's *Frontline* story on Montana's campaign finance laws. As you may have seen and heard, the folks at *Frontline* relied on a bunch of stolen documents that were mostly from my print shop business (very likely altered by now) to claim that Western Tradition Partnership was improperly coordinating with candidates. They laid the blame at the feet of my husband, Christian LeFer, in retaliation for his helping bring the recent campaign finance lawsuits.

Needless to say, this is false. What happened was that a little more than 2 years ago, a bunch of files from from my mailing business and some from Christian's own work as an independent political consultant (which includes ATP as a client) were being transported in my car when it was stolen. The documents reportedly then turned up in a 'meth house' in Denver (no kidding!), were passed along to Democratic party operatives in Colorado, and then shipped to the Montana Commission on Political Practices (COPP) who decided to claim they were property of Western Tradition Partnership. 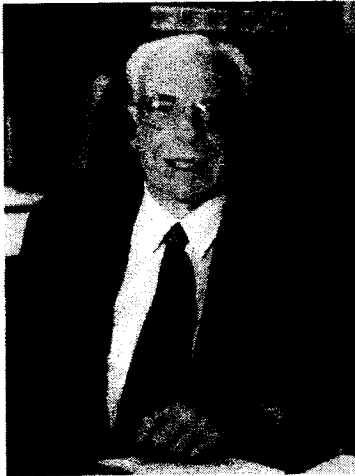
Guess what: nobody's picking up those choice cabins.

Individual and Entities Who Violated Montana Campaign and Finance Laws and Regulations

1. Western Tradition Partnership/American Tradition Partnership, 200 Pennsylvania Ave. # 186, Washington, DC, 20006;
2. Taxpayers for Liberty (TFL), a WTP/ATP entity, 2047 N. Main Street, Helena, MT 59047;
3. Assembly Action Fund (AAF), a WTP/ATP entity, Lewistown, MT;
4. Montana Citizens for Right to Work (MCRW), an agent/affiliate of WTP/ATP, PO Box 1112, Livingston, MT 59047;
5. Christian Lefer, an agent of WTP/ATP/MCRW, PO Box 1112, Livingston, MT 59047;
6. Allison Lefer, an agent of WTP/ATP/MCRW, PO Box 1112, Livingston, MT 59047;
7. Donald Ferguson, an agent/officer of WTP/ATP, Washington, DC;
8. Direct Mail and Communications/General Consulting, an agent of WTP/ATP, PO Box 1112, Livingston, MT 59047;
9. Doug Lair, a director of WTP/ATP, PO Box 1591, Big Timber, MT 59011;
10. Geoff Goble, a director of WTP/ATP, 387 Old Boulder Road, Big Timber, MT 59011;
11. Peter MacKenzie, a director of WTP/ATP, PO Box 1809, Livingston, MT 59047; and
12. John Does 1-50. Unknown persons, businesses, or entities who may have authorized, directed, contributed, or participated in the activities of WTP/ATP/AAF/MCRW.

Violations of Montana Campaign Finance Laws

Western Tradition Partnership/American Tradition Partnership/Taxpayers for Liberty/Assembly Action Fund/Montana Citizens for Right to Work violated the following Montana campaign and finance laws:

1. Violation One: WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW violated §§ 13-37-225, 13-37-228, and 13-37-229, MCA by failing to report contributions and expenditures in the 2010 and 2012 election cycles.
2. Violation Two: WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW violated § 13-37-226, MCA by failing to file the appropriate forms required by Montana law including but not limited to a C-2 statement of organization, C-6 political committee finance reports, and C-7 pre-election expenditure reports.
3. Violation Three: WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW violated § 13-37-228, MCA by failing to file the necessary closing reports as required by Montana law.
4. Violation Four: WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW violated § 13-35-225, MCA by failing to use the legally required disclaimer on election materials. The disclaimer fails to name a treasurer as required by Montana law on election materials. Please see materials provided by Bruce Tutvedt in his complaint against WTP/ATP/Taxpayers for liberty and the complaint filed by Debra Bonogofsky against Montana Citizens for Right to Work.

Liability of Agents, Officers, and Directors

The agents, officers, and directors of WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW are personally liable for all fines, penalties, and other sanctions resulting from the violations listed above under the following statutes:

1. Section 13-35-105, MCA. Under Montana law, a person who aids and abets the conduct of a person who violates a provision of Montana election law is also guilty of a violation of that provision.
2. Section 28-10-702, MCA. Under Montana law, a person who assumes to act as an agent is responsible to third persons when the agent's acts are wrongful in their nature.

Request for Relief

I request your office seek the following relief against WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW and its entities, officers, directors, and agents:

1. A fine against each party in the amount of three times the amount spent by WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW and the other associated entities in the 2010 and 2012 election cycles under § 13-37-128, MCA. It is my understanding WTP/ATP alone spent roughly \$500,000 in the 2010 election cycle. Thus, for the 2010 election cycle, I would request a fine against each person or entity who committed violations in the 2010 election cycle for the amount of \$1,500,000 just for the WTP/ATP expenditures. I would request other equivalent fines based upon the amount of spending by the other entities in 2010 and 2012;
2. An inspection of documents and reports under § 13-37-121, MCA and issuance of orders of noncompliance as authorized by law;
3. An injunction pursuant to § 13-35-108, MCA to prohibit WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW and its entities, associates, affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors, treasurers, and agents from spending any money or performing any election related activity until WTP/ATP/TFL/AAF/MCRW are in compliance with Montana law; and
4. Any other relief necessary to enforce Montana campaign finance and practices laws.

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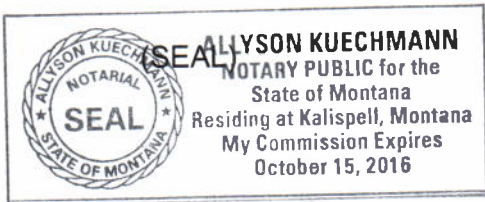

I am writing to request an investigation and imposition of fines and penalties against the following for violating Montana campaign and finance laws:

5. Western Tradition Partnership/American Tradition Partnership
6. National Gun Owners Alliance, PO Box 2268, Merrifield, VA 22116
7. Christian and Allison Lefer, PO Box 1112, Livingston, MT 59047
8. Direct Mail and Communications, PO Box 1112, Livingston, MT 59047
9. John Does 1-50. Unknown persons, businesses, or entities including officers and directors of the above listed entities who may have authorized, directed, contributed, or participated in the activities of the National Right to Work Committee and its affiliates.

Factual Background Necessary for Investigation

This complaint is being filed against National Right to Work Committee and its affiliates, agents, officers, and directors for violations of Montana campaign finance and practices laws. For many years, the National Right to Work Committee has operated a secret political mail operation. The National Right to Work Committee owns its own printing presses and has the ability to produce thousands of mailings in less than a few weeks. During the 2008, 2010, and 2012 election cycles the National Right to Work Committee through its affiliates and agents mailed thousands of pieces of election material to Montana voters. The National ProLife Alliance, National League of Taxpayers, National Association of Gun Rights, National Gun Owners Alliance, and Western Tradition Partnership/American Tradition Partnership are nothing more than front groups/agents of the National Right to Work Committee and act under the direction of the National Right to Work Committee.

Although the National Right to Work Committee has taken various steps to conceal the connection of the front groups/affiliates, there is enough publically available information to suggest a connection between the National Right to Work Committee and entities identified above. The National Right to Work Committee is located at 8001 Braddock Road, Suite 500 in Springfield, VA 22160. The National ProLife Alliance is located at 5211 Port Royal Road, Suite 500, Springfield, VA 22151. It is believed these addresses are for the same office building. The office building where the National Right to Work Committee is located is at the intersection of Braddock Road and Port Royal Road in Springfield, Virginia. An analysis of Google Maps shows the same office building is used for both addresses.

The connection between these entities is more apparent when reviewing other publically available information. According to documents submitted to the Federal Elections Commission, the treasurer for the National ProLife Alliance PAC is Steve Antosh. Mr. Antosh's personal residence is 3237 Fairfax, VA. (Fairfax County Treasurer Records). This is the same address as the National League of

Taxpayers. The President of the National Gun Owners Alliance is Dennis Fusaro who was also a prominent member of the National Right to Work Committee. The National Gun Owners Alliance has also used the same mailing address as the National League of Taxpayers.

Christian Lefer is the officer of Montana Citizens for Right to Work. Montana Citizens for Right to Work is financed by the National Right to Work Committee. See National Right to Work IRS Tax Returns. Mr. Lefer has also acted as an agent of Western Tradition Partnership/American Tradition Partnership. On information and belief, the National Right to Work Committee contributed to and/or financed the political operation of Montana Citizens for Right to Work/Western Tradition Partnership/American Tradition Partnership. These entities have never filed any of the necessary paperwork required by Montana law and have never disclosed any contributions and/or expenditures. The complaint filed by Bruce Tutvedt shows a flyer paid for by the National Association for Gun Rights. The bulk mail postage stamp shows the flyer originated from the same mail house as the mailers sent by Western Tradition Partnership. It is believed the mailers were produced by Christian Lefer and/or Direct Mail and Communications.

Violations of Montana Campaign Finance Laws

The National Right to Work Committee and its affiliates and agents have violated the following Montana campaign finance and practices laws:

1. Violation One: National Right to Work Committee/National Pro-life Alliance/National League of Taxpayers/National Association for Gun Rights/National Gun Owners Alliance violated § 13-37-225, 13-37-228, and 13-37-229, MCA by failing to report contributions and expenditures in the 2008, 2010, and 2012 election cycles.
2. Violation Two: National Right to Work Committee/National Pro-life Alliance/National League of Taxpayers/National Association for Gun Rights/National Gun Owners Alliance violated § 13-37-226, MCA by failing to file the appropriate forms required by Montana law including but not limited to a C-2 statement of organization, C-6 political committee finance reports, and C-7 pre-election expenditure reports.
3. Violation Three: National Right to Work Committee/National Pro-life Alliance/National League of Taxpayers/National Association for Gun Rights/National Gun Owners Alliance violated § 13-37-228, MCA by failing to file the necessary closing reports as required by Montana law.
4. Violation Four: National Right to Work Committee/National Pro-life Alliance/National League of Taxpayers/National Association for Gun Rights/National Gun Owners Alliance violated § 13-35-225, MCA by failing to use the legally required disclaimer on election materials and/or surveys. The disclaimers fail to name a treasurer as required by Montana law.
5. Violation Five: National Right to Work Committee/National Pro-life Alliance/National League of Taxpayers/National Association for Gun Rights/National Gun Owners Alliance violated Montana Administrative Rule 44.10.323 by coordinating with candidates for elected office in

the State of Montana through its agents Christian Lefer and Direct Mail and Communications.

Liability of Officers, Directors, and Agents for Acts of National Right to Work Committee and its Affiliates

The officers, directors, and agents of the National Right to Committee and its affiliates should be held personally liable for all fines, penalties, and other sanctions resulting from the violations listed above under the following statutes:

1. Section 13-35-105, MCA. Under Montana law, a person who aids and abets the conduct of a person who violates a provision of Montana election law is also guilty of a violation of that provision.
2. Section 28-10-702, MCA. Under Montana law, a person who assumes to act as an agent is responsible to third persons when the agent's acts are wrongful in their nature.

Tolling of Statute of Limitations

The limitation of action applicable to claims under Montana election laws should not apply to any claims asserted against any party to this complaint because the National Right to Work Committee and its affiliates and agents took steps to conceal the nature of the National Right to Work Committee's involvement in Montana elections. See § 27-1-102(3), MCA.

Request for Relief

I request your office seek the following relief as a result of the violations of Montana law:

1. A fine against each party in the amount of three times the amount spent by the National Right to Work Committee and its affiliates in all election cycles where the National Right to Work Committee participated in any election related activity;
2. An inspection of documents and records under § 13-37-121, MCA and the issuance of orders of noncompliance as authorized by law;
3. An injunction pursuant to § 13-35-108, MCA to prohibit the National Right to Work Committee and its affiliates from spending any money or performing any election related activity in Montana until the National Right to Work Committee and its affiliates are in compliance with Montana law; and
4. Any other relief necessary to enforce Montana campaign finance and practices law.
