COPP Compliance Specialists have recently been notified that certain materials supporting your candidacy do not appear to include the full 'paid for by' attribution message as required (see the attached photos). Each material would require an attribution message of 'paid for by' with the candidate's name ***and campaign address*** under [13-35-225](#), Mont. Code Ann. You will need to add the full required attribution message to all copies of this material and email a photo to the COPP showing the attribution message added; please do so no later than the end of the day Tuesday, April 19, 2022 (2 business days from today)- per 13-35-225(6), Mont. Code Ann. COPP would also require the number of items an attribution message was added to and the date the material was distributed as part of this message.
