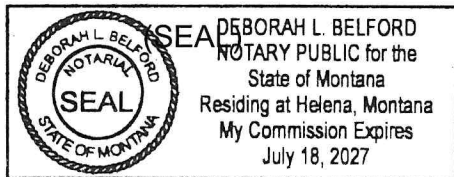

Pursuant to MCA 13-37-226 regarding candidate timely filing procedures, this complaint is addressing Candidate for Montana House District 81 Mary Caferro and the late filings of her campaign for 2024. As of June 20, the deadline for this cycle's reporting timeframe, Mary Caferro had not filed her financial reports. She filed them 2 days late. This sets a bad precedent and is unfair reporting to the public and other candidates. Reporting deadlines are set for transparency and honesty in Montana political campaigning, and no one should be held to a different standard. Ms. Caferro knows what the deadlines are, as she has stated many times how much experience she has representing the public of Montana.
